ΠΕΡΙΛΗΨΗ

Το παρόν πολυγλωσσικό λεξικό δημιουργήθηκε με τη συνεργασία εκπαιδευτικού και μαθητών με στόχο την εκμάθηση βασικού ελληνικού λεξιλογίου και την ενίσχυση της διαπολιτισμικής επικοινωνίας. Περιλαμβάνει 201 λέξεις (ουσιαστικά, επίθετα, φράσεις) οργανωμένες σε θεματικές κατηγορίες σχετικές με την καθημερινή ζωή, το σχολείο, τις ανθρώπινες σχέσεις, τα ζώα και τα φαγητά. Οι λέξεις σε κάθε ενότητα έχουν τοποθετηθεί σε αλφαβητική σειρά. Κάθε λέξη συνοδεύεται από μετάφραση στα αγγλικά, γερμανικά, ρωσικά, αραβικά, ισπανικά και τούρκικα, καθώς και από εικόνες που δημιουργήθηκαν από τους μαθητές με τη βοήθεια τεχνητής νοημοσύνης. Παράλληλα, δημιουργήθηκε ψηφιακό υλικό με ηχητικά αρχεία προφοράς από τους ίδιους τους μαθητές, ώστε να διευκολύνεται η εκμάθηση και η σωστή προφορά των λέξεων. Το έργο αυτό προάγει τη συνεργασία, τη γλωσσική πολυμορφία και τον αλληλοσεβασμό μέσα στη σχολική κοινότητα.



ΠΡΟΛΟΓΟΣ

Η δημιουργία του παρόντος πολυγλωσσικού λεξικού προέκυψε από την ανάγκη υποστήριξης των μαθητών με διαφορετικό γλωσσικό και πολιτισμικό υπόβαθρο στην καθημερινή σχολική και κοινωνική τους επικοινωνία. Στόχος του έργου ήταν η εκμάθηση βασικού ελληνικού λεξιλογίου με έναν βιωματικό, δημιουργικό και συνεργατικό τρόπο, αλλά και η ενίσχυση της αλληλεπίδρασης ανάμεσα στους μαθητές μέσα από την ανταλλαγή γλωσσικών και πολιτισμικών στοιχείων.

Παράλληλα, δημιουργήθηκε ένα εκπαιδευτικό παιχνίδι καρτών λεξιλογίου, το οποίο αξιοποιήθηκε βιωματικά στην τάξη για την εκμάθηση βασικών ελληνικών λέξεων μέσα από ομαδικές και διαδραστικές δραστηριότητες. Οι λέξεις που περιλαμβάνονται στο παιχνίδι αποτέλεσαν στη συνέχεια τη βάση για τη δημιουργία του πολυγλωσσικού λεξικού, ώστε τα δύο έργα να λειτουργούν συνδυαστικά και συμπληρωματικά. Μέσα από τη συμμετοχή τους οι μαθητές συνεργάστηκαν δημιουργικά, γνώρισαν διαφορετικές γλώσσες και πολιτισμούς και ενίσχυσαν την επικοινωνία και την αυτοπεποίθησή τους.

Κατά τη διάρκεια της υλοποίησης του παρόντος προγράμματος οι μαθητές συμμετείχαν ενεργά στην επιλογή των λέξεων, στη μετάφρασή τους, στη δημιουργία εικόνων με τη βοήθεια της τεχνητής νοημοσύνης και στην ηχογράφηση της προφοράς κάθε λέξης στη μητρική τους γλώσσα. Μέσα από αυτή τη διαδικασία καλλιεργήθηκαν η συνεργασία, η δημιουργικότητα, ο αλληλοσεβασμός και η αποδοχή της πολυγλωσσίας και της διαφορετικότητας.

Θα ήθελα να ευχαριστήσω θερμά όλους τους μαθητές που συμμετείχαν με ενθουσιασμό και συνέπεια στην υλοποίηση του έργου, καθώς και τις οικογένειές τους για τη στήριξη και τη συνεργασία τους. Ιδιαίτερες ευχαριστίες αξίζουν επίσης στη σχολική κοινότητα για την υποστήριξη και την ενθάρρυνση αυτής της προσπάθειας. Ευχόμαστε το λεξικό αυτό να αποτελέσει ένα χρήσιμο εργαλείο μάθησης και επικοινωνίας για όλους τους μαθητές των επόμενων σχολικών χρόνων.
